Due to the ongoing issues with Parramatta grass on some holes The Match Committee have made some changes to hopefully help with this. Also I asked Jono for a report regarding the Index on the Red Course. This was over a period of six months and indicates that some of the Hole Indexes needed adjusting. There will be three new Tee Beds on the 4th, 6th and the 13th holes and the Index will change also on those holes. The 16th Hole will just be an Index change. I have asked if these changes could be implemented for the 28th January, 2025. MiScore will also be adjusted for the new Index and Distance. We will not be getting New Cards, so anyone using cards will need to be aware of the changes.
